Direct Tier 3 Interventions

Direct Tier 3 Intervention	Description
<b>Individual Counseling</b>	Short-term (6–8 weeks), solution-focused counseling provided to students as appropriate to address the severe lack of progress, crisis situations, or other Tier 3 needs
<b>Crisis Response: Self-Harm Assessment</b>	Evaluation of the potential risks of a student harming <i>themselves</i>
<b>Crisis Response: Threat Assessment</b>	Evaluation of the potential risks of a student harming <i>others</i>
<b>Crisis Response: CPS Report</b>	Agency contact for suspected child abuse or neglect
<b>Intensive Post-Suspension/Alternative School Re-Engagement Counseling</b>	Student meeting to discuss the student’s transition back to school from a suspension or alternative school setting
<b>Referral to and Collaboration with Internal/External Supports</b>	Referral of the student (and family, if appropriate) to additional Tier 3 supports, both within or outside of the school (i.e. mental health counseling, food depositories, shelters)
