Dr. Paul Harris currently serves as founder of Integrity Matters, LLC, which exists to promote racial justice through social emotional learning in education, athletic, and faith communities. He previously served as a tenured Associate Professor of Education at The Pennsylvania State University and the University of Virginia and as a high school counselor in Newport News and Loudoun County, VA. He earned his Bachelor's degree in Health & Physical Education with a concentration in Sports Medicine and his Master's degree in School Counseling from the University of Virginia, and his Ph.D. in Counselor Education from the University of Maryland. He also holds a Master of Divinity degree from Virginia Union University.

Dr. Harris is the former president of the Virginia School Counselor Association and a former member of the Board of Directors for the American School Counselor Association. He also formerly served on the editorial review board for the *Professional School Counseling* journal. He currently serves on the Senior Advisory Board for *The Professional Counselor* journal.

In collaboration with education scholars, practitioners, and community partners, Dr. Harris has co-authored over 35 peer-reviewed manuscripts and book chapters. His contributions to the field have been acknowledged by the American School Counselor Association, American Educational Research Association, Southern Association of Counselor Education and Supervision, and Education Trust.
